What is ON THE MOVE?

This is a time when our young people can come together virtually, in their family groups, and do some stuff at home and in their neighbourhood which shows God's love for the community. There will be the usual time for fellowship and bible teaching – except this year it will be done online. But what still sets On the Move aside from other events is that during the day the young people share God's love in their communities. So, even though things will be different this year, it will still be a great opportunity to show how we can actually live out our Christian faith in a local area.

The daily programme will include morning worship and wind-up each morning via the diocesan Facebook page; suggestions for practical activities to do during the day; a time of sharing in the evening.

Our move online means the young people's time will have to be monitored and supervised by parents/guardians. For child protection and safeguarding reasons, it is essential that parents/guardians know what the children are doing, what they are viewing online and what they are posting/sending. For this reason, all correspondence, links and invitations to virtual meetings will be sent via a parent's phone or email account only.

We appreciate that this involves considerable effort on your part, but we feel that you, the young people and your neighbourhood will enjoy the On The Move time within your own family and across the diocesan family.
