



Sunday 13th September – Exodus 14:19-31 – Moses crossing the Red Sea

Read: Exodus 14:19-31

After Pharaoh told Moses he could leave Egypt, he quickly changed his mind and set off after Moses and the Israelites. I am sure everyone was terrified of what was going to happen – especially when they came to the Red Sea! The Red Sea was before them and Pharaoh and his army behind them – it must have seemed like an impossible situation, but again God had a plan! God changed the weather conditions, the clouds, the wind, and the tides all change direction. A path is cleared in the middle of the Red Sea and Moses and the Israelites are able to walk through on dry land with a wall of water on either side. It really was a miracle. God did this for his people to show his love to them, and as a result of Moses' obedience to him. The Israelites are free but still have a great journey ahead of them to The Promised Land.
