



Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> June – Jesus calms the storm

**Read:** Mark 4:35-41

Jesus asked his disciples to go over to the other side of the lake, so they left the crowd behind and they got in a boat and headed off. As they were sailing a storm came up and waves crashed over the boat and it was about to sink. Jesus was in the back of the boat and was sleeping. The disciples were terrified but Jesus slept! The disciples woke Jesus up and asked 'Don't you care if we drown?' Jesus got up and ordered the wind to stop and told the wind to be quiet. Everything stopped – all was completely calm. Jesus then asked his disciples why they were afraid and did they not have any faith? The disciples were terrified and asked who this was – even the wind and waves obey him! The disciples were able to see the true power of Jesus.
